Freshly elected President Macron seized the opportunity to establish his leadership position (Young, aged 39) on the international scene by responding promptly and warmly to American President Trump. He used a very cunning and symbolic diplomatic tactic that will mark the spirits. Who would blame him? It is very cunning, and very well seen, because the slogan became viral and was the tweet most relayed in the days that followed on the canvas in France and elsewhere.

The other very strong and symbolic gesture was the speech in English by President Francis Macron, who thus broke the codes, as he has been used since he was candidate for the presidency and then his election. Never had a French head of state used the language of Shakespeare in a speech filmed at the Elysee.
