THE STORY

OUR REVIEW:

This is the Story of Motherless Urchin Mary who, because she's so Smart and has a Ruthless Maternal Granny, Evelyn, gets separated from her beloved Uncle Frank, her soft-hearted Neighbour Roberta Taylor and a one-eyed cat Fred. So they live a Simple Life in Florida where Frank fixes Boat Engines; the grime under his nails (and the beer he swigs) suggesting that he's firmly rooted in the Working Class...

The Film handles the Blend of Comedy and Drama effectively. The gifted Young Actress playing Mary, who has already amassed a lengthy list of Film and Television Credits, delivers a Superb Performance here that bodes well for her future. All of the performances are terrific. The film's Melodramtic Beats are predictable but arehit with Absolute Precision... There's enough Believable Chemistry between Chris Evans and Mckenna Grace for it all to work.
