PARIS PHOTO 2017-Largest International Art Fair dedicated to Photographic Medium

November 9 to 12 at Grand Palais (PARIS)

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USPA NEWS - PARIS PHOTO, the World's Largest International Art Fair dedicated to the Photographic Medium, will hold its 21st Edition November 9th through 12th, 2017 at the Historic Grand Palais in Paris. The Annual Event for Collectors, Professionals, Artists, and Enthusiasts, Paris Photo offers to its Visitors the most qualitative and diverse Selection of Artworks alongside an Ambitious Public Programme with Leading Figures in the Field.

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Over 180 Galleries and Publishers will present a Complete Panorama of the History of Photography : from Vintage and Modern Works to Contemporary Creations, Rare and Limited Editions, and Avant-Premiere Book Releases. The PRISMES Sector, launched in 2015 in the prestigious Salon d'Honneur, will feature a curated presentation of Large Format, Series, and Video and/or Installation Works.

PARIS PHOTO is the occasion for Visitors to expand their Knowledge of the Medium thanks to Exhibitions, Awards, Signature Sessions, Special Events, and Talks and Discussions with Artists, Curators, Critics, and Historians.
