The Marvel Films are so much fun not because of what happens in them, but because of the ways their Stars, Directors and Craftsfolk find to innovate within the Series´ tightly circumscribed Formal Limits. This last one was directed by the New Zealand Filmmaker Taika Waititi who puts the plot technically revolving around Ragnarok (an Apocalypse meant to signify the End of Days in the Mythical Realm of Asgard) being basically an Excuse to have Thor interact with a Parade of Nutjobs. Taika Waititi is best known for lovable, considerably smaller-scale Movies. This Time, he unlocks untapped Comedy Reserves in Chris Hemsworth... Thor´s Family Problems are at the Root of this Busy Sag!
