Three books on Rashtrapati Bhavan “‘Life at Rashtrapati Bhavan’; “‘Indradhanush “‘ Volume II’ and “‘Rashtrapati Bhavan: From Raj to Swaraj’ were released at a function held at Rashtrapati Bhavan on Dec 11, by the President of India, Mr. Pranab Mukherjee, Vice President of India, Mr. Mohd. The book “‘Life at Rashtrapati Bhavan’ is an attempt to record the human history of the residents living in the President’s Estate.
