He regrets the self-censorship of women who do not dare to engage in politics following the glass ceilings of accessibility to certain management positions on boards of directors. Emmanuel Macron went to meet the women (the day before the day of the woman), of the city of Mureaux, in the Parisian suburbs. He met, among others, "Mouriatou is a" Standing Mom "who is fighting for the future of the youths of the Mureaux especially facing the problems of employment and housing. "We are working for the children of tomorrow," she confided to Emmanuel Macron.

In the neighbourhoods, young people are discriminated against like this medical secretary who applied to hold kiosks on weekends. "The boss did not call me back because my resume showed that I lived in Les Mureaux," says a young woman in front of Emmanuel Macron who replies: Employment, two measures:

- Free jobs: a premium of 15 000 euros over 3 years for any company that hires a person living in political district of the city.
- Develop checks against discrimination based on name or address: develop the practice of "testing" and "name and shame" in Les Mureaux. The candidate Macron, the forty candidate running for French Presidency is at ease as much in front of the 1,500 leaders of the global summit (Women's Forum see article:) as in front of mothers, in a more social context and what is more, in a neighbourhood popular. This comfort makes it easier for her to promise to be committed to women and to fight against discrimination.
