Here is the content of President Hollande's remarks, few hours after the shooting. "At 9 pm an attack was made to target the police officers as their bus. One policeman was killed and two wounded policemen and one wounded were injured. The assailant was killed. A national homage will be fiat tomorrow for the policeman who has died for his country. The whole area was curled up and the people present were evacuated and we are convinced that the leads that can lead during the investigation that will reveal the whole truth are terrorist and I called a defense council tomorrow morning. My thoughts go to the relatives and police families and ISIS claims the shooting of Thursday April 20th night on the Champs-Elysees.

Mobilisation is at the highest level in the circumstances that we know, and high vigilance within the framework of the electoral process and even after. I reiterate all the commitments with regard to the gendarmes and the military and the police, the safety of our fellow citizens and police officers who are exercising their profession for the security of the country and this goes to the same of the military policemen and gendarmes, Citizens that they know that they will be protected and assured, but the basic principle is trust, solidarity and support for the nation. This is my very sad message about this policeman dying by serving his party and the other wounded and fighting terrorism here and abroad. " President Francois Hollande
