Place Bell will be a Unique Place for the Public to get together to enjoy Sports and Cultural Activities. On the Olympic and Community Rinks, Laval's Budding and High-Level Athletes will hone their Speed Skating, fFgure Skating, Hockey and Ringette Skills. Hockey Fans and Entertainment Seekers will also be delighted with the New Cultural Activities offered here as well as the Brand New Team on the Territory: the Laval Rocket.

Place Bell will be Exhibiting Two Superb Works of Art. Like a Receiving Line, Michel Goulet's Faire la Vague Installation will welcome Visitors on the Outdoor Grounds. This Work of Art consists of 14 Posts, which represent the 14 Former Municipalities in Laval. Then in the Foyer, Artist Louise Viger's La Voie Des Souffles Sculpture will make its Symbolic Colours and Shapes Sparkle: Gold, Silver and Bronze.

In addition, a Public Artwork Project to pay Tribute to Henri Richard will also be integrated into Place Bell. With the Consent of the Richard famil (who is involved in the Project) the Public Work of Art will be installed Next Spring on the Walls of the Main Entrance to Place Bell.
