FRENCH MINISTRY FOREIGN AFFAIRS OFFERS A €2 M AID TO THE VICTIMS OF EARTHQUAKE OF MOROCCO TO SUPPORT SOLIDARITY ACTIONS OVER EARTHQUAKE IN MOROCCO

"The Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs is activating, at the request of Minister Catherine Colonna, the external action fund for local authorities in order to support solidarity actions which will be deployed in agreement with the Moroccan authorities for the benefit of populations affected by the earthquake.

Already, several local authorities have approached the Ministry of Europe and Foreign Affairs for an amount of aid of nearly two million euros (€ 2M). In addition, many French companies have informed the Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs of their intention to contribute financially or in kind to the support that France will provide to the victims of the earthquake, in agreement with the Moroccan authorities."
