This man, born in Courcouronnes Essonne was listed for Islamist radicalisation since 2010. He would be radicalised in Chartres, where the Police spotted him in 2010. According to the Paris prosecutor Francois Molins, he had "Never been involved" in a terrorist case. For now, investigators are trying to find out if he has indeed stayed in Syria in 2014. This small repeatedly offender has-been condemned for common crimes between 2004 and 2010 without never staying in prison.------

Seven members of his family were taken into custody and their homes were raided Saturday night. Among them, his father, a brother and wife of the latter were heard by the police. "It's crazy, it's madness ..." responded the brother on Saturday before police custody. He said he had no contact from Omar Ismail Mostefai for several years and has not imagined he became radicalised.

Near the body of a suicide bomber from the Stade de France, investigators found a Syrian passport in the name of Mohammad al Ahmad, 25. It was presented by an asylum seeker arrived in Greece before taking the Balkan route. An unknown names of French services. This man would come to Serbia on October 7, the country where he applied for asylum. It could be genuine, or also be a false passport, bought abroad or stolen in Europe.
